Discussion and Review of County Ordinances – Judge Schneider

Judge Schneider presented a copy of the proposed ordinance changes that had been suggested by the Ordinance Sub-Committee that had met previously.

Chapter 95 was reviewed by the Magistrates, Judge Schneider and County Attorney Steve Gold. The Humane Society has submitted an outline of suggestions concerning the ordinance. Many of the suggestions made by the Humane Society expanded the sections of the current ordinance, making them very detailed. In section 95-3 All agreed that many of the definitions of a “Dangerous Dog” of “Vicious Dog” are subjective and could be hard to enforce specifics of the ordinance if a case actually had to go before a jury. Discussion ensued regarding what exactly needed to be written in the ordinance and also the allowed actions by Animal Control Officers.

Part of the suggestions from the Humane Society was to introduce a “Hot car law” for dogs & cats. This will be added but after enforcement actions can be determined.

License fees need to be looked at to make it easier to get your dog licensed. This may require an agreement between the Humane Society and local vets.


Steve will make the changes that were talked about present back to the court for review.
