Discussion and Review of County Ordinances – Judge Schneider

Chapters 186, 214, 220 & 230 were reviewed by the Magistrates, Judge Schneider and County Attorney Steve Gold.

All agreed with the redline changes to Chapter 186 Pawnbrokers which eliminates the complete chapter.

Judge asked County Engineer Bill Hubiak if he had any changes that he felt needed to be made to Chapter 214 – Streets & Sidewalks. He replied that he did not feel any changes needed to be made. Magistrate McCollom asked if we core new streets prior to them being accepted by the county. Bill explained they do not core but they visually inspect each phase of the street being created.

Judge Schneider ask if parts of section 214-5 should be incorporated into chapter dealing with nuisances. County Attorney Steve Gold agreed. He will look at it and work on writing it into chapter 176


There were no suggested changes to Chapter 220- Taxation.

For chapter 230, Bill Hubiak will go over the list of internal streets with the speed limit set at 20 mph and make sure they are correct and provide an updated list to the County Attorney. He would also to recommend that the Ridge Lane speed limit set at 15 mph be raised to 20 mph leaving no county roads with a 15 mph limit. No members disagreed. Bill along with the sheriff's department will take note when out in the county that speed limit signs are properly posted.

There being no further business to come before the court, Magistrate Southard made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Magistrate Berry.
