Discussion and Review of County Ordinances - Judge Schneider

Appendix B, Appendix C and Chapters T1, T2 & T3 were reviewed by the Magistrates, Judge Schneider and County Attorney Steve Gold.

Brian Bishop, Planning Commission Director stated that Appendix B – Subdivision Regulations, was being reviewed by the planning commission and any suggested changes will be presented to the Fiscal Court. They are looking at changing the shoulder widths on industrial roads and also changing the way building permits are issued to make it easier for builders in their own development. Once a policy is created it will be sent to the Fiscal Court for review.

Bill Hubiak addressed Appendix C – Public Improvement Specifications. He would like to add a statement in section 1.13 – Erosion and water pollution control to add the words: changes comply with MS4 requirements.

After some discussion it was decided that chapters T1, T2, & T3 were not required. Most had not been updated since 2014. Since there are constant changes to Agreements, & Franchises it would require constant updating with the company costing the county money. It was decided that it would be more beneficial to keep spreadsheet in-house with this information on.

There being no further business to come before the court, Magistrate Southard made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Magistrate Puttman.
